## Lily Photo Contest

**Eligibility:** the Photo Contest is open to ORLS members as well as non-members.

**Scope:** All photos must feature “true” lilies (genus *Lilium*). Photos must clearly depict the subject(s) as a member of the genus *Lilium*. The focus of the photos is lilies. People, insects, animals and other subjects/objects are allowed as long as they do not dominate the image.

### Entry Divisions:

**Division A:** Amateur photographers only. Photos cannot have been entered in previous ORLS Photo Contests.

**Division A winners are determined by ballots cast by Show attendees. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place ribbons will be awarded. Vote tabulation takes place Sunday July 7th at 12:00pm. Winners will be announced at the Awards Ceremony at 2:00pm.**

**Division A - enter one or all, classes - one entry per class per participant allowed**

**Class 1 Close up** – Beauty is in the details

**Class 2 Vista** - Any landscape or garden featuring lilies

**Class 3 Companions and Pollinators** – Your opportunity to include butterflies, bees, insects and human companions with your lily(lilies) - remember the focus is on the lily/lilies.

**Division B:** Exhibition Division: Open to all photographers and any previously entered photographs in NALS-affiliated shows.

**Entry information:**

1. Photos must be 8"x10" or 8 1/2"x11" in size, and must be mounted on 1/8" or 1/4" thick cardboard, poster-board, or foam-board of the same size as the photo.
2. The back of the photo must contain the following information:
  - a. Entrant's name, address (mandatory), phone number, e-mail (optional)
  - b. The Division the photo is to be entered in - either "Div A" or "Div B"
  - c. The name of the lily or lilies "Unknown Lily" or "Unknown Lilies" is acceptable
3. Where deemed appropriate, the Show Committee has the right to place photos in a Division different from the one the photographer indicated, or refuse displaying a photo altogether.
4. Participants retain all legal rights to their photos, but grant ORLS permission to use entered photos for noncommercial educational and promotional purposes such as liliium web-sites, written publications, etc.
5. Entry deadline: individually delivered entries must be received by Saturday, July 6, 2023 at 10:30am (prior to the start of show judging); these entries may be dropped off at the photo-display area in the Atrium. You can contact Marilyn Cornwell to make special drop-off time arrangements.
6. Participants may pick up their entries at the end of the Lily Show, Sunday July 7, 2023 between 2:00 & 3:00 pm. Entries not picked up will become part of the Lily Society's library.
